

All-Terrain Vehicle Injury Prevention Checklist

- Attend an ATV driver's safety course.
- Never use a 3-wheeler. They are unsafe and no longer manufactured.
- Ride an age-appropriate ATV. The American Academy of Pediatrics recommends that no one under 16 years of age ride a full size ATV.
- Provide constant supervision when children are operating an ATV.
- Never carry passengers. ATVs are designed for one person.
- Do not use ATVs on the streets or at night.
- Always wear an approved helmet with eye protection.
- Wear non-skid, closed toe shoes.
- Wear long pants and a long-sleeve shirt.
- Never operate an ATV under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
