This program offers insight from a patient's perspective on the course of events that unfold as a result of a car crash, from the frantic 911 call, to the Emergency Department trauma bay experience, to recovery in the Trauma Intensive Care Unit.

Program Overview:

- Two hour Workshop
- Reality-based demonstration
- Tours of Emergency Department, Burn Trauma Intensive Care Unit and Helipad
- Educate young drivers/passengers about consequences of their decisions
- Groups of up to ten 15 to 19 year olds

Workshops are generally held the first Friday of each month in the morning. Special arrangements can be made for groups.
