Proclamation

WHEREAS, in the United States, injuries, which include unintentional injury, suicide, and homicide, are the leading cause of death and disability among people ages 1 to 44; and

WHEREAS, in the United States, 278,345 people died by injury in 2020 including 2,646 in New Mexico; and

WHEREAS, in New Mexico, unintentional injuries are the leading cause of death for people ages one to nine and 15-54, and the third leading cause of death overall; suicide is the leading cause of death for children ages 10-14 and the tenth leading cause of death overall; and homicide is in the top four leading causes of death among those under age 35; and

WHEREAS, most injuries can be prevented through a combination of policy, education, safety engineering, and distribution of safety devices; and

WHEREAS, the state of New Mexico is committed to creating a safe environment contributing to the safety and well-being of all New Mexicans; and

WHEREAS, factors such as limited social, educational, and economic opportunity, unstable housing, rigid gender roles, and daily stresses of violence and racism increase injury risk; and WHEREAS, supporting and strengthening families, building stable connections with peers and adults, improving communication, problem-solving and conflict resolution skills, and fostering a

strong connection to school and community can create long-lasting, effective prevention; and

WHEREAS, hospitals, state agencies, and community organizations are committed to their crucial roles in reducing injuries and deaths by promoting evidence-based injury prevention policies and practices; and

WHEREAS, there is a need for greater capacity-building and community collaboration to reduce the burden of injury in New Mexico; and

WHEREAS, National Injury Prevention Day raises awareness and promotes efforts to prevent injuries and injury-related deaths.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Michelle Lujan Grisham, Governor of the State of New Mexico, do hereby proclaim November 18, 2022 as:

"National Injury Prevention Day"

throughout the state of New Mexico.
