WHEREAS: Unintentional injuries are the leading cause of death for children in Iowa; and

WHEREAS: While the number of injuries and deaths vary across the state, every county in Iowa is impacted

by these events; and

WHEREAS: Many of these injuries and deaths are preventable with the use of injury prevention education

and equipment and the implementation of strong legislation; and

WHEREAS: Hospitals, state agencies, community organizations, and other partners are crucial in promoting

safe practices; and

WHEREAS: The State of Iowa is committed to promoting efforts in reducing injuries among children:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kim Reynolds, Governor of the State of Iowa, do hereby proclaim November 18, 2020, as

NATIONAL INJURY PREVENTION DAY
